



- 151611** RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A PLAN, FOR BOARD APPROVAL, FOR A PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN INFORMING THE RESIDENTS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY THAT: (1) THE MIAMI-DADE EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY (MDX) IS A STATE AGENCY, SEPARATE AND APART FROM THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, WITH THE SOLE AUTHORITY TO SET AND CONTROL TOLL RATES; AND (2) THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HAS PASSED LEGISLATION URGING MDX TO: (I) AVOID FUTURE TOLL INCREASES; (II) CONSIDER REDUCING TOLL RATES OR CAPPING THEM AT EXISTING LEVELS; (III) ELIMINATE THE USE OF THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) AS THE BASIS FOR TOLL INCREASES; (IV) STUDY THE ISSUE OF RISING TOLLS ON MDX EXPRESSWAYS, WITH INPUT FROM THE PUBLIC; AND (V) IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON CONTINUALLY RISING TOLL RATES, WHICH HEAVILY BURDEN THE COUNTY'S LOW AND MIDDLE INCOME RESIDENTS, WHILE MDX STUDIES THE ISSUE OF RISING TOLLS AND PRESENTS ITS FINDINGS TO THE PUBLIC AND TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
