RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 104<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE  
FROM SW 48<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO SW 45<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS  
PABLO AGUILAR, JR. AVENUE

**WHEREAS**, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 48<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 45<sup>th</sup> Street as Pablo Aguilar, Jr. Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. was born in Miami on October 27, 1982 with a debilitating spinal condition called multiple pterygium syndrome; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. endured 17 major operations, including cleft palate repair, orchiopexy, tracheostomy, hip release, pharyngeal flap correction and spinal fusion, and sustained plastic surgery, speech therapy and physical therapy; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. was able to overcome these and many more obstacles in life; and

**WHEREAS**, despite these obstacles, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. graduated first in his academy for the class of 2000 with a GPA of 4.9, and was awarded one of 12 four-year scholarships awarded nationally by the Chairscholars Foundation, an organization that recognizes physically challenged students with exceptional academic records; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. was awarded the Venture National Scholarship, Stanley E. Jackson Scholarship, Florida Brights Future Scholarship, Legal and Public Affairs Support Foundation, Academic Scholarship and the Miami-Dade County Youth Fair Scholarship. He also won an honorable mention 2000 Silver Knight award in the vocational technical category; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. was selected Outstanding Public Service Education student by the Dade Association of Vocational, Career and Community Education; and

**WHEREAS**, Pablo Aguilar, Jr. passed away July 7, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Pablo Aguilar, Jr. with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 48<sup>th</sup> Street to 45<sup>th</sup> Street as Pablo Aguilar, Jr. Avenue.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Authority, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Police Department, and the Fire Department.
