

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF FEES FOR
NUEVO CAMINAR MINISTERIO CATOLICO FOR THE USE
OF THE DADE COUNTY AUDITORIUM ON OCTOBER 12,
2003 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1800

WHEREAS, Nuevo Caminar Ministerio Catolico, translated as “New Path Catholic Ministries” (the “Ministry”), is a non-profit organization dedicated to assist families struggling with substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry will be sponsoring a dance and symphony recital on October 12, 2003 at the Dade County Auditorium; and

WHEREAS, all proceeds raised in this event will benefit the Ministry’s drug rehabilitation program in Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, the admission fees for this event will total \$1800; and

WHEREAS, to limit the costs of the recital, the Ministry has asked this Board to waive the admission fees,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board approves a fee waiver of admission fees incurred by the Ministry on October 12, 2003 for the use of Dade County Auditorium in an amount not to exceed \$1800.
