

RESOLUTION APPROVING ALLOCATION OF DISTRICT 6  
OFFICE BUDGET FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500 EACH  
TO SEVENTEEN PUBLIC SCHOOLS LOCATED WITHIN THE  
BOUNDARIES OF DISTRICT 6

**WHEREAS**, education is a primary concern to the residents of District 6, being necessary for the development of a new generation of informed and productive citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, quality public school education is particularly critical to the long-term intellectual and social development of the youth in our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the public schools in District 6, and elsewhere in Miami-Dade County, face constant budget problems that threaten to compromise the quality of the education these schools provide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parent-Teacher-Students Association (PTSA) of each public school in District 6 performs the vital function of maintaining communication between parents and educators to ensure the best possible education of public school students; and

**WHEREAS**, support for the PTSA and for public school education in District 6, and throughout Miami-Dade County, is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board approves the allocation of FY 2003-2004 District 6 office funds in the amount of \$500 to the PTSAs of each of the following seventeen public schools located with the boundaries of District 11:
