RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR THE CREATION OF A DATABASE OF CONTRACTOR PAST PERFORMANCE FOR USE IN EVALUATING QUALIFICATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY OF BIDDERS FOR COUNTY CONTRACTS AND FOR USE IN EVALUATING WHETHER TO EXERCISE OPTIONS TO RENEW EXISTING CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, knowledge of a contractor's past performance record will enable the County to make a more informed decision on that contractor's responsibility when bidding for a County contract and will serve to assure that County contracts are not awarded to a contractor with a poor performance history; and

WHEREAS, such knowledge will also assure that options to renew existing County contracts are not exercised in favor of a contractor with a poor performance history,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is directed to develop a plan for creation of a database of contractor past performance for use in evaluating qualifications and responsibility of contractors for County contracts and for use in evaluating whether to exercise options to renew existing County contracts. The plan shall provide a means of incorporating information into the database that is available from federal, state and local sources regarding contractor past

performance. The County Manager shall develop and present such plan to this Board within ninety (90) days of adoption of this resolution.
