

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING PARKING PERMITS FOR PERSONS TRANSPORTING YOUNG CHILDREN AND STROLLERS TO AMIGOS TOGETHER FOR KIDS, D/B/A AMIGOS FOR KIDS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 94-104 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private non-for-profit non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children; and

WHEREAS, Amigos Together for Kids, d/b/a Amigos for Kids, is a 501(c)3 non-profit agency providing services for abused, abandoned, neglected and less fortunate children,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is hereby directed to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers to the following agency in the following amount:
