

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE SEPTEMBER 26, 2004 "CICAMEX" FESTIVAL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,600

WHEREAS, "Carnaval Independencia Centro America y Mexico, Inc." (CICAMEX) has requested use of two Park and Recreation Department stages in an amount not to exceed \$1,600 for its September 26, 2004 festival celebrating the independence of Central American countries and Mexico and promoting understanding and harmony among the people of Miami-Dade County (See attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and
