RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 35TH STREET FROM
SW 62ND AVENUE TO SW 67TH AVENUE AS MARIBEL
GARCIA STREET

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 35th Street from SW 62nd Avenue to SW 67th Avenue as Maribel Garcia Street; and

WHEREAS, Maribel Garcia was born November 20, 1964 in Pinar del Rio, Cuba; and

WHEREAS, Maribel Garcia began her career with the Miami-Dade Police Department in October 1996, graduated with BLE Class #180 in August 1997. She was released to full duty and was assigned to the Hammocks District in February 1998; and

WHEREAS, Maribel Garcia while at the Hammocks District quickly established a reputation as an earnest, enthusiastic young officer unafraid to confront the risks inherent to police work; although confident in her abilities, she was mindful that her learning was never over, and she never stopped trying to improve; and

WHEREAS, Maribel Garcia's files reflect all of this and contain numerous commendations for outstanding performance of duty and professionalism; and

WHEREAS, Maribel Garcia was an advocate of healthy living, speaking before various groups about her experiences with breast cancer and the importance of cancer awareness and regular health screenings; and

WHEREAS, Mirabel Garcia died of cancer on July 4, 2003, and is survived by her parents, Florentino and Josefina, her brother Robert, nieces and nephew and life-long friend Alicia Diaz; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Maribel Garcia with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 35th Street from SW 62nd Avenue to SW 67th Avenue as Maribel Garcia Street.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Authority, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Police Department, and the Fire Department.
