Miami-Dade Home Rule Charter Amendments Relating to Salaries and Terms of County Commissioners

- In an effort to encourage more persons who are dedicated to good government to run for office, shall County Commissioners no longer receive the \$6,000 annual salary established in 1957, but receive instead the salary provided by a State statutory formula based on population used by other Florida counties, including Broward County (currently approximately \$84,213), and
- Commencing with the election of County Commissioners in 2006, shall Commissioners be limited to four consecutive four-year terms?
