



Subject: County-wide In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The county-wide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a non-profit organization Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation for their Annual Walk-A-Thon at Miami Metro Zoo scheduled for March 12, 2005.

In-kind services have been requested in the amount of \$25,300 from the Park and Recreation Department for the entrance fee for approximately 5,000 people at the special event rate of \$5.00 and the field rental fee of \$300. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve funds.

In FY 2004-05, Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation has not received any allocations.
