

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF ADMISSION FEES AND THE FIELD RENTAL FEE AT METROZOO FOR THE ANNUAL SICKLE CELL WALK SPONSORED BY 100 BLACK MEN OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. ON JANUARY 8, 2005 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,800

**WHEREAS**, 100 Black Men of South Florida, Inc. has requested a waiver of admission fees and the field rental fee in an amount not to exceed \$1,800 for the January 8, 2005 Annual Sickle Cell Walk at Miami Metrozoo (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the Sickle Cell Walk is a County-wide event and the in-kind services shall be funded from the County-wide In-Kind Reserve Budget,

**Subject:** Countywide In-Kind Request Recommendations

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The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends that the item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

## Background

A waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization 100 Black Men of South Florida, Inc. for their annual Sickle Cell Walk-A-Thon at Metrozoo scheduled for January 8, 2005.

In-kind services have been requested in the amount of \$1,500 from the Park and Recreation Department for Metrozoo entrance fees for approximately 300 people and a waiver of the field rental fee of \$300 for a total in-kind amount of \$1,800. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve.

In FY 2004-05, the 100 Black Men of South Florida, Inc. has not received any County funding.

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
