RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF PROPERTY APPRAISAL TO HOLD AN
ANNUAL AGRICULTURAL CLASSIFIED VALUE
WORKSHOP

WHEREAS, each year the County's Property Appraiser is responsible for classifying and assessing all agricultural property within Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for the Miami-Dade County Department of Property Appraisal to hold an Annual Agricultural Classified Value Workshop for the purpose of providing information to and receiving relevant market data and information from the County's commercial agricultural producers and growers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, that the Miami-Dade County Department of Property Appraisal shall conduct an Annual Agricultural Classified Value Workshop with the assistance of the Miami-Dade County Office of the Florida Cooperative Extension Services. This annual workshop shall be held no later than the second week of May each year at 9:00 A.M., as determined and scheduled by the Property Appraiser and the Agricultural Cooperative Extension Service, at the auditorium of the Miami-Dade County Office of the Florida Cooperative Extension Services located at 18711 SW 288 Street. At this annual workshop the Miami-Dade County Department of Property Appraisal will discuss the requirements necessary to qualify for a classified land valuation for bonafide agricultural uses and the valuation techniques used to prepare the classified values of land used for bonafide agricultural purposes. At this annual

workshop, the Department of Property Appraisal will also receive from commercial agricultural producers and growers relevant market data and financial information which may assist the department in developing and formulating appropriate market value and agricultural land rates.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Katy Sorenson and offered by Commissioner _____ who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
