

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 128TH STREET FROM SW 107TH AVENUE TO SW 117TH AVENUE AS MATTHEW O. GRIBBLE STREET

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 128th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 117th Avenue as Matthew O. Gribble Street; and

WHEREAS, Matthew O. Gribble was born on March 28, 1962 in Galveston, Texas, but lived in Miami, Florida most of his life; and

WHEREAS, Matthew O. Gribble went to Miami Palmetto Senior High where he was named Dade's Swimmer of the Year twice; and

WHEREAS, Matthew O. Gribble attended the University of Miami; during his freshman year at UM in 1980, he made the U.S. Olympic team but never got a chance to compete when President Jimmy Carter pulled the United States out of the Moscow Games; he also was a member of the Hall of Fame for the University of Miami; and

WHEREAS, Matthew O. Gribble in, 1982, grabbed the world's attention when he beat favored German Michael Gross for the gold medal at the World Games in Ecuador; a year later he won three more gold medals at the Pan American Games; he set the 100-meter butterfly World Record in 1983, and was a member of the U.S. Olympic Teams in 1980 and 1984; and

WHEREAS, Matthew O. Gribble passed away on March 21, 2004 due to a vehicle accident and is survived by his companion Jeanne Ripoll, his son Trahern O. and step-son Willie Ripoll, his parents John and Barbara, brothers David and Mark and sister Lenore; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Matthew O. Gribble with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 128th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 117th Avenue as Matthew O. Gribble Street.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Authority, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Police Department, and the Fire Department.
