

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS FOR ARYA SAMAJ OF MIAMI, INC.'S MARCH 27, 2005 ANNUAL SPRING FESTIVAL AT LARRY AND PENNY THOMPSON PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,679 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 9 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Arya Samaj of Miami Inc. has requested in-kind services for its March 27, 2005 Annual Spring Festival at Larry and Penny Thompson Park from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation, valued at \$1,671, and the Miami-Dade Police Department, valued at \$1008 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Applications); and

WHEREAS, the Arya Samaj of Miami Inc. Annual Spring Festival is a district event and the in-kind services will be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund,

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A not-for-profit organization Arya Samaj of Miami, Inc. is requesting a waiver for in-kind services for their annual Spring Festival scheduled for March 27, 2005.

In-kind services have been requested in the amount of \$1,671 from the Park and Recreation Department for use of Larry & Penny Thompson Park Shelters 2 and 4, and \$1,007 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services, for a total in-kind amount of \$2,678. This event will be funded from the District 9 district specific in-kind reserve.

In FY 2004-05, Arya Samaj of Miami Inc., has not received any County funding.
