



Subject: Ordinance relating to the Programming Partnership Program

This ordinance relating to the Programming Partnership will not have a fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County.

The item requires Programming Partners (not-for-profit recreational program provider; youth soccer leagues, optimists and khoury leagues, etc) currently providing services at County park facilities to display picture identification. It also requires Programming Partners to verify immigrant status. The current permits already require background checks for all volunteers and coaches working at County park facilities and is the responsibility of the Permittee. The additional costs associated with the issuance of picture identification and immigrant status check would be the responsibility of the programming partner, therefore resulting in no fiscal impact to the County.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26-33 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY RELATING TO THE PROGRAMMING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM; IMPOSING IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS AND REQUIRING PROOF OF LEGAL IMMIGRANT STATUS ON PERSONS VOLUNTEERING AND WORKING FOR PROGRAMMING PARTNERS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this Board desires to enhance security at County parks facilities by creating additional requirements in Section 26-33 of the Code of Miami-Dade County relating to Programming Partners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 26-33 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 26-33. Background Checks >>and Identification Requirements<<

>>A.<< All Programming Partner staff and volunteers who will have direct contact with program participants, at their expense, must show proof of official statewide background checks (either through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement or the Miami-Dade Police) for substance abuse, family violence and crimes of moral turpitude. The Department will seek a cooperative agreement with the Miami-Dade Police Department to provide such services at a discount for Partners. >>All Programming Partner staff must show proof of legal immigrant status in the

United States and an official work permit. The Programming Partner shall keep records of all background checks, proof of legal immigrant status, and records of official work permits.

B. All Programming Partner staff and permanent volunteer coaches shall wear a picture identification at all times while on County property and at all times when in direct contact with program participants.<<


Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 4. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.


Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
