ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 93-91, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 96- 101, TO RESCIND TWO CENTS OF THE REMAINING THREE CENTS OF THE 1993 FIVE CENTS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX; DIRECTING CLERK OF THE BOARD TO MAIL CERTIFIED COPY HEREOF TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE IN TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN CODE AND EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 8 of Ordinance No. 93-91, as amended by Ordinance No. 96-101, is hereby amended to rescind two cents of the remaining three cents of the 1993 Five Cents Capital Improvements Local Option Gas Tax.

Section 2. Nothing herein shall operate to impair the obligation of any bonds backed by the proceeds of the 1993 Five Cents Capital Improvement Local Option Gas Tax.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Board is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Florida Department of Revenue in Tallahassee, Florida.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 5. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may

be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 6. If not vetoed within ten (10) days after the date of adoption, or if vetoed within such 10 day period and thereafter overridden by this Board, this ordinance shall become effective January 1, ____ and the rate of 1993 Capital Improvement Local Option Gas Tax levied on every gallon of motor fuel sold from that date on in Miami-Dade County and taxed under the provisions of Part I of Chapter 206 Florida Statutes shall be one cent.
