

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM OF PLACING SIGNS ON BULKY WASTE TRASH PILES TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE STATUS OF THE REMOVAL OF SAID BULKY WASTE TRASH PILES

**WHEREAS**, the current system for the collection of bulky waste involves the placement of bulky waste at the curb and calling for a pickup by the Solid Waste Department; and

**WHEREAS**, from the public perception there is no method to tell the status of the pickup of the bulky waste pile; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no outward method to differentiate between an illegally placed bulky waste pile and a pile which has been appropriately placed and pickup called for; and

**WHEREAS**, the public is left to wonder whether or not bulky waste piles at curbside have been properly called in,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the County Manager is hereby directed to develop a plan for the placement of signs at or near bulky waste piles within the Department of Solid Waste's service area, which signs will notify the public as to whether or not a pickup has been ordered and the approximate date of the pickup of bulky waste pile. Said report shall include the cost of implementation of this program. Said report shall be provided to this Board of County Commissioners within sixty (60) days of the approval of this resolution.
