

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 32ND
STREET FROM SW 87TH AVENUE TO SW
97TH AVENUE AS SAINT JOHN BAPTIST
DE LA SALLE BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 32nd Street from SW 87th Avenue to SW 97th Avenue as Saint John Baptist De La Salle Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Saint John Baptist De La Salle is the father of modern education, the founder of popular education and of the Normal Schools for teachers; and

WHEREAS, Saint John Baptist De La Salle founded schools for poor children in Paris, France in 1796, at a time when only the children of nobility were educated one on one by tutors. He initiated the concept of the classroom with one teacher for many children. From France, his educational concepts spread throughout the world, including the United States; and

WHEREAS, in Cuba alone, there were 11 Saint John Baptist De La Salle Schools until they were confiscated by the communist government in 1961. Thousands of alumni from the Saint John Baptist De La Salle Schools immigrated to the United States and used the education and knowledge acquired in these schools to help them succeed in Miami-Dade County in distinguished professions and careers in business, medicine, law, engineering, architecture, government and politics among others; and

WHEREAS, the alumni of the De La Salle Alumni Association have requested by signature this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 32nd Street from SW 87th Avenue to SW 97th Avenue as Saint John Baptist De La Salle Boulevard.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Authority, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department, the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Police Department, and the Fire Department.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Senator Javier D. Souto and offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was second by Commissioner _____, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


