



Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration.

Background

Felix Varela High School Naval Junior ROTC has requested a wavier for in-kind services for their annual track and field competition scheduled for October 22, 2005.

In-kind services have been requested in the amount of \$775 from the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for emergency services during the event. The in-kind services provided by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department do not affect the countywide in-kind reserve.

In FY 2004-05 the Felix Varela High School Naval Junior ROTC did not receive any County funding.

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
