

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 112TH
AVENUE FROM SW 40TH STREET (BIRD ROAD)
TO SW 56TH STREET (MILLER ROAD) AS
CAPTAIN OSVALDO RAMIREZ AVENUE

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 112th Avenue from SW 40th Street (Bird Road) to SW 56th Street (Miller Road) as Captain Osvaldo Ramirez Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Captain Osvaldo Ramirez was born in Sancti Spiritus, Cuba on June 21st, 1922; and

WHEREAS, Captain Osvaldo Ramirez was a simple laborer from Sancti Spiritus, Cuba who transported sugar cane to earn his living; and

WHEREAS, in 1960 under the direction of the Eisenhower Administration, he joined groups of armed soldiers in the Escambray Mountains to lead the battle to liberate Cuba from the communist dictatorship of Fidel Castro; and

WHEREAS, Captain Osvaldo Ramirez was the best known and most feared guerrilla fighter in Cuba's modern history; and

WHEREAS, Captain Osvaldo Ramirez was killed in battle on April 16th, 1962 and was survived by his wife Estrella and now by all his children; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Osvaldo Ramirez with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 112th Avenue from SW 40th Street (Bird Road) to SW 56th Street (Miller Road) as Captain Osvaldo Ramirez Avenue.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Authority, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Police Department, and the Fire Department.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Senator Javier D. Souto and offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was second by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
