



RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY'S PROFESSIONAL STAFF TO CORRECT THE RECORD WHEN MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION PROVIDE INACCURATE FACTUAL OR LEGAL INFORMATION DURING A COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2006, this Board enacted Resolution 214-06 directing the County's professional staff to correct the record when a member of the public who is addressing the Commission presents inaccurate information; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to impose the same standard of accuracy to members of the County Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that during meetings of the County Commission, the County Manager is directed to correct the record when a County Commissioner makes an inaccurate factual statement and the County Attorney is directed to correct the record when a County Commissioner makes an inaccurate legal statement.
