

ORDINANCE AMENDING RULE 5.05 (c) OF SECTION 2-1 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY RELATING TO "4-DAY RULE"; PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTION FOR ITEMS CONTAINED IN COUNTY'S LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 2-1. RULES OF PROCEDURE OF COUNTY COMMISSION

PART 5. CONDUCT OF MEETINGS; AGENDA

Rule 5.05 AGENDA

* * *

(c) "4-DAY RULE". A copy of each agenda item shall be furnished the members of the commission not later than four (4) working days before a vote may be called on the item. The provisions of this rule shall be deemed waived unless asserted by a commissioner before the board takes action on the resolution, ordinance, motion or other item in question. The provisions of the rule may not be waived under rule 7.01(n); however, this rule is not applicable to special or emergency meetings called pursuant to Rule 3.02 >>or to items related to the County's legislative package<<.

¹ Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

not applicable to special or emergency meetings called pursuant to Rule 3.02 >>or to items related to the County's legislative package<<.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
