

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT FOR THE MARCH 12, 2006, MAY 28, 2006 AND JUNE 18, 2006 COLOMBIAN CONGRESSIONAL ELECTIONS, SPONSORED BY THE CONSULADO GENERAL DE COLOMBIA, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,848.71 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Consulado General de Colombia has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Elections Department for the March 12, 2006, May 28, 2006 and June 18, 2006 Colombian Congressional Elections in an amount not to exceed \$5,848.71 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, Consulado General de Colombia is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Colombian Congressional Elections is a countywide event, and the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Elections Department for the March 12, 2006, May 28, 2006 and June 18, 2006 Colombian Congressional Elections in an amount not to exceed \$5,848.71 to be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund.

Sunday, May 28th, 2006


And a rain date (run off) Sunday, June 18th, 2006





Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services is being requested by the Colombian Consulate for their upcoming elections for congress in Colombia scheduled for March 12, May 28 and if needed due to rain or run-off June 18, 2006.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$1,605.30 from the Park and Recreation Department for use of the Tamiami Park Recreation Center, \$3,872.16 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services, and \$371.25 from the Elections Department for use of tables and chairs for a total in-kind amount not to exceed \$5,848.71. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve.

In FY 2005-06, the Colombian Consulate has not received any County funding.

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
