



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING A CASH ALLOCATION AND IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DECEMBER 10, 2005 INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY CONCERT SPONSORED BY SISTERS AND BROTHERS FOREVER, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$94,004.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 13 DISCRETIONARY RESERVE FUND, THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND AND THE FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT BUDGET

**WHEREAS**, Sisters and Brothers Forever, Inc. has requested a \$50,000 cash allocation from the District 13 Discretionary Reserve Fund, \$43,504.00 in in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and \$500.00 in in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue District Budget for the December 10, 2005 “International Human Rights Day” concert at Amelia Earhart Park (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the celebration of human rights is devoted to promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms that enhance partnership and cooperation at all levels; and
