



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 29, 2006 WALKAMERICA, SPONSORED BY THE MARCH OF DIMES, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$34,142.44 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the March of Dimes has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the April 29, 2006 WalkAmerica in an amount not to exceed \$34,142.44 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, March of Dimes is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the WalkAmerica is a countywide event, and the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the April 29, 2006 WalkAmerica in an amount not to exceed \$34,142.44 to be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund.

Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization March of Dimes for their WalkAmerica walk-a-thon scheduled for April 29, 2006.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$28,192.80 from the Park and Recreation Department for use of Crandon Park and \$5,949.64 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services for a total in-kind amount of \$34,142.44. The countywide in-kind reserve will fund this event.

In FY 2005-06, the March of Dimes has not received any County funding for this event.

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
