

VICTIMS' WEEK IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, this Board is aware that through this country, state, and county there exist individuals who have been victims of crimes; and

WHEREAS, these victims of crimes have suffered both physical, psychological and financial damages due to the criminal conduct of others; and

WHEREAS, there is an overall perception that these individuals have little or no positive recognition and in many situations are forgotten and suffer silently due to situations beyond their control; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to send a message to all victims of crimes that we consider their rights to be essential and important; and

WHEREAS, nationally, the week of April 23rd through April 29th 2006 has been designated National Crime Victims Rights Week,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board declares April 23rd through April 29th, 2006 to be National Crime Victims' Week in Miami-Dade County.
