

RESOLUTION JOINING THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AND
URGING THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO CODESIGNATE A
PORTION OF SW 8TH STREET FROM SW 62ND AVENUE TO
SW 67TH AVENUE AS RAMON PUIG WAY

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating a portion of SW 8th Street from SW 62nd Avenue to SW 67th Avenue as Ramon Puig Way; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2004, the City of West Miami adopted Resolution Number 2004-43 approving this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County takes pride in recognizing one of its own, a man who has, through his work, maintained a Cuban tradition for four decades; and

WHEREAS, Ramon Puig has tailored Guayaberas for numerous dignitaries and United States President Ronald Reagan, and others too numerous to mention; and

WHEREAS, Ramon Puig has been recognized by publications such as the Miami Herald,

G.Q. Fashion Magazines and international publications as “El Rey de la Guayabera”; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners joins the City of West Miami and urges the Florida Legislature to approve this codesignation.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this resolution to the members of the Miami-Dade County Delegation of the Florida Legislature, the Mayor and the City Commission of the City of West Miami.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department, the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
