



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE FEBRUARY 24-26, 2006 FESTIVAL FOR THE POOR SPONSORED BY ST. LOUIS CATHOLIC CHURCH, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$941.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 7 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

**WHEREAS**, St. Louis Catholic Church has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 24-26, 2006 Festival for the Poor in an amount not to exceed \$941.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, St. Louis Catholic Church is a not-for-profit organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the Festival for the Poor is a district event, whose proceeds shall be donated to the Miami Rescue Mission, the Daily Bread Food Bank, Camillus House, the Missionaries of Charity, Kristi House and St. Ann's Mission; and

**WHEREAS**, the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 7 In-kind Reserve Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 24-26, 2006 Festival for the Poor in an amount not to exceed \$941.00 to be funded from the District 7 In-kind Reserve Fund.

**Subject:** District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

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The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization St. Louis Catholic Church for the Festival for the Poor event held on February 24-26, 2006.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$941 from the Park and Recreation Department for use of a stage. This event will be funded from the District 7 district specific in-kind reserve.

In FY 2005-06 the St. Louis Catholic Church has not received any County funding.

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
