

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 3-21 OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO MODIFY THE BID AWARD POSTING PROCEDURES FOR CONTRACTS BETWEEN \$25,000 AND \$100,000 AND TO INCREASE THE THRESHOLD OF THE INFORMAL SOLICITATIONS FROM \$100,000 TO \$250,000

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 3-21 was established pursuant to Section 4.02 of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Amendment and Charter and Section 2-8.4 of the Code of Miami-Dade County to establish procedures for the filing and resolution of bid protests; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission wants to permit greater flexibility in the posting of award recommendations for contracts and purchases involving expenditures of over \$25,000 up to and including \$100,000 and increase this threshold to \$250,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is directed to amend Section III of Administrative Order 3-21 to permit the posting of award recommendations for contracts and purchases involving expenditures of over \$25,000 up to and including \$250,000 on any working day rather than exclusively on Mondays.
