

RESOLUTION JOINING THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI
CODESIGNATING N.E. 135TH STREET EAST OF
BISCAYNE BOULEVARD AS "ARCH CREEK EAST
BOULEVARD"

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating N.E. 135th Street east of Biscayne Boulevard as Arch Creek East Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Arch Creek East is an organized neighborhood east of Biscayne Boulevard in the City of North Miami; and

WHEREAS, N.E. 135th Street is the main thoroughfare in the Arch Creek East neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2006 the City of North Miami passed resolution No. R-2006-52 approving this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 4,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board joins the City of North Miami in approving the codesignation of N.E. 135th Street east of Biscayne Boulevard as Arch Creek East Boulevard.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the City of North Miami Mayor and City Council, United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department

and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
