



RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 179TH
STREET FROM SW 107TH AVENUE TO SW
102ND AVENUE AS REVEREND JOE L.
SUMPTER, SR. STREET

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 179th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 102nd Avenue as Reverend Joe L. Sumpter Sr. Street; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. accepted the appointment of God and the call of the St. Peters Missionary Baptist Church family as their pastoral leader in the year 1987; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. not only had love for the church, he also had a love for the community of West Perrine. He was a community activist with a Church-like spirit; he was a willing worker striving to better the environment and conditions of the citizens of the West Perrine Community; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. served as president of the West Perrine Christian Association; he also was actively affiliated with the Christian Alliance, the One Church-One Child Program, a program orchestrated under Governor Jeb Bush, West Perrine Community Development Corporations, a faithful supporter of the annual West Perrine MLK Activities, the Office of Black Affairs, and a recipient of numerous awards and accolades; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. passed away on September 22, 2005;
and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 9,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 179th Street from SW 107th Avenue to SW 102nd Avenue as Reverend Joe L. Sumpter, Sr. Street.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
