



RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 133RD
AVENUE/SW 133RD AVENUE ROAD/SW 135TH
AVENUE FROM KENDALL DRIVE (SW 88TH
STREET) TO SW 79TH STREET AS RAYMOND R.
STANISKY ROAD

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 133rd Avenue/SW 133rd Avenue Road/SW 135th Avenue from Kendall Drive (SW 88th Street) to SW 79th Street as Raymond R. Stanisky Road; and

WHEREAS, Officer Raymond R. Stanisky was born in Ambridge, Pennsylvania on September 25, 1933; and

WHEREAS, Officer Raymond R. Stanisky attended the University of Miami; he also served in the United States Army Infantry; and

WHEREAS, Officer Raymond R. Stanisky, in 1960, joined the Miami-Dade Police Department; during his law enforcement career he was assigned to then Central Services, the jail, civil warrants and the airport, serving honorably until his retirement in 1985; and

WHEREAS, Officer Raymond R. Stanisky, on October 8, 1999, while working as a security guard, attempted to apprehend three bank robbers and was murdered at age 66; and

WHEREAS, Officer Raymond R. Stanisky is survived by his wife, children and grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the Winston Park Homeowners Association Board of Directors on June 1, 2006, approved the renaming of SW 133rd Avenue/ SW 133rd Avenue Road/SW 135th Avenue from SW Kendall Drive (SW 88th Street) to SW 79th Street as Raymond R. Stanisky Road; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Officer Raymond R. Stanisky with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 133rd Avenue/SW 133 Avenue Road/SW 135th Avenue from Kendall Drive (SW 88th Street) to SW 79th Street as Raymond R. Stanisky Road.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.


