

Subject: Resolution Authorizing a Transfer of Jurisdiction for County Owned Right-of-Way for NW 74 Street, from the Florida Turnpike East for Approximately 1213 feet, in Sections 7 and 18, Township 53 South, Range 40 East

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the attached resolution authorizing a transfer of jurisdiction of a portion of Miami-Dade County owned right-of-way to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The subject right-of-way being transferred is a portion of NW 74 Street from the Florida Turnpike East for approximately 1213 feet. The Public Works Director recommends approval of this jurisdictional transfer.

BACKGROUND

The South 44 feet of the subject right-of-way was acquired by Miami-Dade County on October 17, 2000, by virtue of the Plat of DORAL NW ENTRANCE as recorded in Plat Book 156, Page 69, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County. The North 35 feet was deeded to the County on December 22, 1950, as recorded in Deed Book 3383, Page 584.


The FDOT is in the process of constructing a new interchange for the Florida Turnpike at NW 74 Street. In order to accommodate the approaches to said interchange, FDOT needs approximately 1213 feet of the existing right-of-way along NW 74 Street, East of the Florida Turnpike. At this time, FDOT has requested that said right-of-way be transferred to them. The Public Works Department has no objections to this jurisdictional transfer.

FISCAL IMPACT

The transfer of jurisdiction for this right-of-way carries no significant fiscal impact.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A COUNTY OWNED RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR NW 74 STREET FROM THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE EAST FOR APPROXIMATELY 1213 FEET TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN SECTIONS 7 AND 18, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County acquired the right-of-way for said portion of NW 74 Street by virtue of the Plat of DORAL NW ENTRANCE, as recorded in Plat Book 156, Page 69, and Right-of-Way Deed, as recorded in Deed Book 3383, Page 584, in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning to build a new interchange for the Florida Turnpike at NW 74 Street; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has expressed a desire to obtain jurisdiction over said portion of NW 74 Street as shown in Exhibit "A" and "B"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,:

1. That this Board approves the transfer of the following County – owned right-of way as legally described in Exhibit "B" to the FDOT.
2. That this transfer of jurisdiction of the above-designated roadway includes the right

and responsibility of the FDOT to maintain the existing right-of-way and infrastructure within this parcel, including road surfacing, sidewalks, storm drainage and landscaping. The FDOT assumes liability for these rights and responsibilities.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



Exhibit "B"
Legal Description
Parcel 104

A portion of Tract 41, **FLORIDA FRUIT LANDS COMPANY'S SUBDIVISION NO. 1** of Section 7, Township 53 South, Range 40 East as recorded in Plat Book 2 at Page 17 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, together with a portion of NW 74 Street as shown on the plat of **DORAL N.W. ENTRANCE**, in Section 18, Township 53 South, Range 40 East as recorded in Plat Book 156 at Page 69 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the SW corner of said Section 7, thence $N01^{\circ}44'52''W$ along the West line of said Tract 41 for 35.01 feet, thence $N89^{\circ}34'55''E$ along a line 35 North of and parallel with the South line of said Section 7 for 40.01 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING** of a parcel of land hereinafter described, thence continue $N89^{\circ}34'55''E$ along said line for 1213.61 feet, thence $S01^{\circ}26'32''E$ for 79.01 feet to a point on the North line of Tract "C" as delineated on said plat of **DORAL NW ENTRANCE**, thence $S89^{\circ}34'55''W$ along said North line of Tract "C" for 1,213.19 feet, thence $N01^{\circ}44'52''W$ along a line 40.00 feet East of and parallel with the West line of said Section 18 for 79.02 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**. Said lands being situated in Miami-Dade County, Florida, containing 2.201 acres more or less.
