

RESOLUTION NO. 1397-06

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO  
UTILIZE THE EXPERTISE OF THE HEAD START PROGRAM  
AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO CREATE A  
PILOT PROGRAM FOR A CHILDREN'S INSTITUTE AND  
PARENTING CENTER

**WHEREAS**, recent incidents reported in the local media have demonstrated that infants and toddlers are being exposed to violence and criminal activities; and

**WHEREAS**, because of their young age and lack of experience, teenage parents often are deprived of positive parenting skills; and

**WHEREAS**, youthful parents often lack positive parenting role models; and

**WHEREAS**, the earlier a child receives intellectual and social stimulation from loving parents, the child is more likely to develop positive self esteem; and

**WHEREAS**, the Head Start / Early Head Start Program administered by the Miami-Dade County Community Action Agency is open to children ages newborn through age 5, and provides care and instruction for children in a classroom setting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Head Start / Early Head Start Program provides comprehensive child development services for low income children and families in Miami-Dade County in the areas of education and early childhood development, health, nutrition, mental health, disability services, social services, and parental involvement; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County Child Development Services, a division of the Department of Human Services, possesses significant knowledge and experience in all areas of child development; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County Public Schools possesses significant knowledge in the area of child development; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to create a Children's Institute and Parenting Center to provide infant, toddler and preschool behavior modification modalities, as well as counseling and parenting skills training for teen parents to promote early intervention and alternatives to violence and physical aggression; and

**WHEREAS**, the Children's Institute and Parenting Center should serve as a therapeutic respite for parents and children; and

**WHEREAS**, the staff of Head Start and Child Development Services, and Miami-Dade County Public Schools should lend their expertise to the development of this program,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA that:**

**Section 1.** The County Manager is directed to utilize the expertise of the Head Start and Child Development Services staff and to coordinate with Miami-Dade County Public Schools to create a pilot program for a Children's Institute and Parenting Center to provide infant, toddler and preschool behavior modification modalities, as well as counseling and parenting skills training for teen parents to promote early intervention and alternatives to violence and physical aggression.

**Section 2.** The County Manager shall submit a written report to the Board of County Commissioners addressing the design for the pilot program and recommending funding strategies within forty-five (45) days of the effective date of this resolution.
