

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE'S DESIGNATION OF STATE ROAD 90/US 41 (SW 8TH STREET) BETWEEN SW 87TH AVENUE AND SW 97TH AVENUE AS EMILIO OCHOA BOULEVARD AND URGING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT MARKERS FOR SUCH DESIGNATION

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has enacted Ch. 2006-316 Laws of Florida, designating State Road 90/US 41 (SW 8th Street) between SW 87th Avenue and SW 97th Avenue in Miami-Dade County as Emilio Ochoa Boulevard and directing the Florida Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers for such designation; and

WHEREAS, Section 334.071, Florida Statutes (2006), provides that erection of markers for such designation shall be contingent on the county commission passing a resolution in support of the foregoing designation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission Districts 10 and 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board supports the Florida Legislature's designation of State Road 90/US 41 (SW 8th Street) between SW 87th Avenue and SW 97th Avenue as Emilio Ochoa Boulevard, and urges the Florida Department of Transportation to erect markers for such designation.
