Subject: Resolution Authorizing the Execution of a Supplemental Lease Agreement for Office
Space Use by U.S. Customs and Border Protection

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the accompanying resolution authorizing the execution of a Supplemental Lease Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the United States of America (Government) for office space use by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) staff at the Dante B. Fascell Port of Miami-Dade.

BACKGROUND

On April 25, 2006, the Board approved Resolution No. R-447-06 authorizing the execution of a lease for real property at 1500 Port Boulevard between Miami-Dade County and the Government for CBP staff stationed at the Port of Miami. This lease agreement contemplated customized tenant improvements to the space prior to occupancy thereby necessitating, upon completion of the build-out, execution of a supplemental lease agreement outlining the actual commencement date of occupancy.

The Seaport Department completed the build-out of office space in October 2006 and the CBP began operations at this facility on November 1, 2006. The attached supplemental lease agreement provides for a three-year lease term commencing on November 1, 2006 and expiring on October 31, 2009. As provided for in the original lease agreement, the Government shall pay the Port of Miami \$502,959.18 in annual rent, with annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments, for usage of 15,747 rental square feet of office space and 63 parking spaces.

FISCAL IMPACT

It is anticipated that this lease agreement will generate approximately \$400,000 in additional annual revenues for the Seaport Department.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SUPPLEMENTAL LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR OFFICE SPACE TO BE USED BY U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION AT THE PORT OF MIAMI; AND TO EXERCISE ALL RIGHTS CONFERRED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that that this Board approves a Supplemental Lease Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the United States of America for office space to be used by U.S. Customs and Border Protection at the Port of Miami commencing retroactively on November 1, 2006, in the annual amount of \$502,959.18 for the first year, with increases tied to the Consumer Price Index in subsequent years; in substantially the form attached and authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to execute same for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County after review by the County Attorney's Office; and to exercise all rights conferred therein.
