## RECOMMENDATION

The attached **Project Award Recommendation** for the Traffic Signal Installation at S.W. 147 Avenue and S.W. 152 Street in Commission Districts 9 and 11 (Project – CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ No. 20050107), in the amount of \$133,183.33, between Raydan Electric, Inc. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

## BACKGROUND

In an effort to accelerate the continued success of the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD is taking advantage of various contracting mechanisms, such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) contract CICC 7360-0/08. Through this process, PWD forwards the Request for Price Quotation (RPQ), by way of facsimile transmission and US-mail, to a pool of firms that have registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review as well as providing courtesy notifications in the Diario De Las Americas, Miami Herald, Miami Times, Haiti en Marche, Le Floridien, and Kiskeya Herald. Interested contractors prepare their bids according to the Job Order Contracting (JOC) process, whereby the County establishes unit prices for the pay items in accordance with industry averages. The contractors submit their bid as an overall percentage factor of the pricing established by the County. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest percentage submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the Department of Business Development's (DBD) Review Committee on November 20, 2006. The Review Committee reviewed and recommended no contract measures for RPQ 20050107. However, in order to expedite the project and in anticipation of receiving no contract measures from the Review Committee, PWD issued an RPQ on November 3, 2006, for a Traffic Signal Installation Contract and forwarded it to a list of 12 pre-registered firms from the OCI database as noted above. Three (3) firms purchased contract documents and two (2) firms proffered a bid. However, All Quality Electrical Services, Inc. bid was declared non-responsive because the firm failed to provide a percentage factor bid as required in the RPQ. As a result, on December 12, 2006, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ 20050107 with a percentage factor of 1.10 to Raydan Electric, Inc. with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, and equipment and tools to perform traffic signal installation(s) including any ancillary work at the intersection of S.W. 147 Avenue and S.W. 152 Street. The contractor shall furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, two (2) pedestrian signal heads and buttons with signs, overhead signs (internally illuminated LED signs), mounting hardware, signal cable, power cable and power services. Additional work to be performed includes installing two (3) vehicle detection loops, three (3) traffic signal poles, signage, pavement markings, and removing existing signs, and pavement markings in conflict with the proposed work. The base contract amount is \$114,950.00, but the total allocated amount is \$133,183.33, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances.

**CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE**

The contractor, Raydan Electric, Inc., is currently performing work for PWD at an above satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager. PWD has reviewed the OCI database and found 11 awarded contracts for Raydan Electric, Inc., with PWD. The referenced database also lists a total of four (4) contractor performance evaluations, all with above satisfactory ratings. The remaining contracts are still under construction or in the preliminary stages and do not yet have evaluations on file.


Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will continue to be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. David Tinder, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, P.E., Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Raydan Electric, Inc., Company Principals are: Ramon Reyes, Helen Reyes and Lazaro L. Hernandez and the Company's address is listed as: 4100 S.W. 94<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Miami, Florida 33165.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$133,183.33 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the Commission Districts 9 and 11 PTP yearly allocations.
