Subject: FIND Grant Proposal for Parking Lot Lights at Haulover Marina

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution authorizing the County Manager or his designee to apply for, accept, amend and expend up to \$375,000 in grant funds from the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND), Waterway Assistance Program to fund parking lot lights at Haulover Marina.

BACKGROUND

FIND is a special taxing district consisting of the 12 eastern counties from Duval to Miami-Dade. The district works cooperatively with the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers to ensure the navigability of the Intracoastal Waterway along the east coast of Florida. The Waterway Assistance Program is a grant program established by the Florida Legislature and the District for the purpose of financially cooperating with local governments to alleviate problems associated with the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway and associated waterways within the District. FIND provided a construction grant for marina facilities of \$1,135,000 in 2005. Each grant requires a match of like amount. The match for this grant, if awarded, will come from the Marina Capital Improvement Fund.

The project will fund parking lot lights for Haulover Marina.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR UP TO \$375,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT TO FUND PARKING LOT LIGHTS FOR HAULOVER MARINA AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND FUNDS, AND EXECUTE GRANT AWARD AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference, and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida:

Project Title: Parking Lot Lights for Haulover Marina

Total Estimated Cost: \$750,000.

Brief Description of Project: Parking Lot Lights for Haulover Marina

AND, Florida Inland Navigation District financial assistance is required for the program mentioned above,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to apply for up to \$375,000 in grant funds from the Florida Inland Navigation District for parking lot lights at Haulover Marina and that the project described above be authorized,

AND, be it further resolved that said Miami-Dade County make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of 50% of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said Miami-Dade County

AND, be it further resolved by Miami-Dade County that it certifies to the following:

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.
2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.
3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Miami-Dade County for public use.
4. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P. L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.
5. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.
6. That it will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.

AND be it resolved that the Board authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to execute such contracts and agreements as are required by this governmental body following approval by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request; to file and execute any necessary amendments to the agreement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida; to expedite the necessary construction contracts and professional services agreements under Section 2-8.2.7 of the Code of Miami-Dade County; and to waive the requirements of Resolution No.R-130-06 to expedite the execution of the grant award agreement.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


