



**Subject:** Resolution Declaring the Acquisition of Land for Right-of-Way Needed for Improvements at the Intersection of SW 97 Avenue (Franjo Road) and US 1 to be a Public Necessity and Authorizing the County Manager and the County Attorney to Employ Appraisers and Expert Witnesses, Obtain Required Environmental Audits and to Take Any and All Appropriate Action to Acquire the Subject Property in Fee Simple, by Donation, Purchase at Values Established by Appraisals, or by Eminent Domain Proceedings, Including a Declaration of Taking as Necessary, for and on Behalf of Miami-Dade County

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution declaring the acquisition of land for right-of-way needed for improvements along SW 97 Avenue (Franjo Road) to be a public necessity, and authorizing the County Manager and the County Attorney to employ appraisers and expert witnesses, obtain required environmental audits and to take any and all appropriate action to acquire the subject property in fee simple, by donation, purchase at values established by appraisals, or by eminent domain proceedings, including a declaration of taking as necessary, for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County.


## BACKGROUND

The Public Works Department (PWD) has programmed the construction of a right turn lane on northbound Franjo Road at the intersection of northbound US-1. The proposed improvements to this intersection qualify as allowable work categories included in the People's Transportation Plan Neighborhood Improvements Section. Adding the right turn lane will greatly improve the efficiency of the intersection by separating the vehicles turning right from vehicles continuing through (crossing US 1) the intersection. This is expected to reduce the "vehicle queue" or "vehicle stacking length" at this leg of the intersection and keep the entrance to Miami Children's Hospital South Dade Center clear of traffic. The right-of-way identified for acquisition is needed in order to construct said right turn lane.

The parcel to be acquired is legally described in Exhibit "A" and illustrated on the parcel location map in Exhibit "B".

## FISCAL IMPACT

The right-of-way acquisition and construction of this project will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the People's Transportation Plan Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project is being allocated from Commission District's 8 yearly allocation.

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR RIGHT OF WAY NEEDED FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG SOUTHWEST 97<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE (FRANJO ROAD) TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER AND THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO EMPLOY APPRAISERS AND EXPERT WITNESSES, OBTAIN REQUIRED ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITS AND TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTION TO ACQUIRE THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN FEE SIMPLE, BY DONATION, PURCHASE AT VALUES ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISALS, OR BY EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS, INCLUDING A DECLARATION OF TAKING AS NECESSARY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:** that this Board hereby declares the acquisition of land for right-of-way needed for improvements along SW 97 Avenue (Franjo Road) to be a public necessity, and authorizing the County Manager and the County Attorney to employ appraisers and expert witnesses, obtain required environmental audits and to take any and all appropriate action to acquire the subject property in fee simple, by donation, purchase at values established by appraisals, or by eminent domain proceedings, including a declaration of taking as necessary, for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County.

The Chairperson thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2007. This resolution shall become effective as follows: (1) ten (10) days after the date of its adoption unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board, and (2) either i) the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has approved same, or ii) in response to the CITT's disapproval, the County Commission re-affirms its award by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Commission's membership and such reaffirmation becomes final.




