Subject: Co-Designation Signs on Traffic Signal Mast Arms

At the February 8, 2007, Board of County Commissioners (BCC) meeting Commissioner Seijas requested that the Public Works Department (PWD) provide a report containing a cost analysis outlining the long-term fiscal impact of installing co-designation signs on traffic signal mast arms.

On February 8, 2007, Resolution No. R-159-07 was adopted directing the County Manager to prominently display all co-designation road signs on available traffic control light mast arms. As such, the PWD conducted an evaluation to determine the number of co-designation signs which were previously ground mounted and could be installed on available mast arms to adhere to this mandate. Said evaluation resulted in a total of approximately, 50 co-designation signs that may be re-installed on mast arms. Of these 50 signs, approximately half are scheduled to be installed through the Department's Illuminated Signs effort this fiscal year. Therefore, PWD is preparing a plan to commence the re-installation of the remaining signs at an approximate cost of \$6,000.00. It is estimated that this work be completed within the next three (3) months.
