

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO REVIEW THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING THE CAPABILITY ON THE COUNTY WEB PORTAL OF RECEIVING POSITIVE FEED BACK ON COUNTY POLICY INITIATIVES

WHEREAS, many media today allow members of the public to telephone in or go to web portals in order to participate in instant, real-time surveys to allow immediate input; and

WHEREAS, creating the capability for Miami-Dade County to use its cable television and web portal in order to allow citizens to give positive feed back could create information in support of county proposals and allow commissioners to gauge the positive support of county policy initiatives,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is directed to report to the full Board of the County Commissioners not later than 90 days from the date of this resolution on the feasibility of creating the capability on the County web portal of allowing citizens to give positive feed back on county policy initiatives.
