

Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization Continental Societies, Inc. Greater Miami Chapter for their Annual 5K walk/Run for Asthma to be held on May 5, 2007 at Miami Metro Zoo.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$615.34 from Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) for police services, \$575.00 from the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue (MDFR) Department for EMS services and \$6,300 from the Park and Recreation Department for Metro Zoo admission fees of not more than 1,000 participants and the picnic field rental fees for a total in-kind amount of \$7,490.34. The in-kind services provided by MDFR, \$575.00 funded by the Fire District in-kind fund. The remaining balance of \$6,915.34 will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2006-07 the Continental Societies Inc. has not received any County funding.
