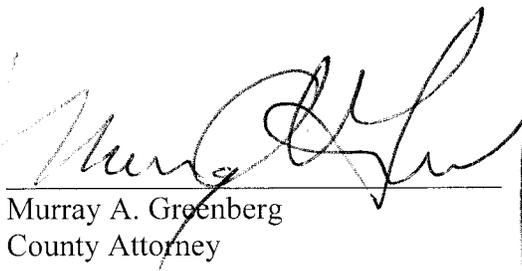

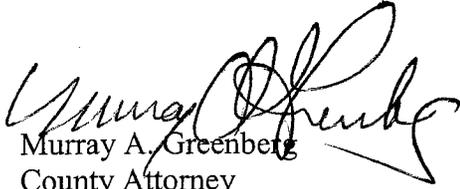

RESOLUTION URGING THE LEGISLATURE TO  
INCREASE FUNDING FOR FLORIDA'S VOLUNTARY  
PRE-KINDERGARTEN EDUCATION PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, on November 5, 2002, the electors of Florida approved Amendment No. 8 to the Florida Constitution, which provided that “[e]very four-year old child in Florida shall be provided by the State a high quality pre-kindergarten learning opportunity in the form of an early childhood development and education program which shall be voluntary, high quality, free, and delivered according to professionally accepted standards”; and

**WHEREAS**, during a special session in December of 2004, the Florida Legislature passed Chapter 2004-484, Laws of Florida, which created a Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Education Program (“VPK Program”) that offered parents a three-hour per day school-year pre-kindergarten program or a full-day summer pre-kindergarten program delivered by either a public school or a private pre-kindergarten provider; and

**WHEREAS**, the VPK Program began in August of 2005 with over 4,300 VPK providers and participation by approximately half of the four-year-olds in Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the VPK Program has made major accomplishments during its first few years of implementation; and

**WHEREAS**, despite its accomplishments, there is still much room for improvement and quality enhancements as the VPK Program moves forward; and

**WHEREAS**, increased funding by the Legislature could ensure the VPK Program is a high-quality system that provides the most qualified and credentialed teachers; and

WHEREAS, increased funding of the VPK Program also will assist families, communities, and our state in realizing the best outcomes for children,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Urges the Florida Legislature to increase funding for Florida's Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Education Program.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of the resolution to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, and the chair and members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

**Section 3.** Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the issues identified in Section 1 above, and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2007 and 2008 State Legislative Packages.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez and Commissioner Joe A. Martinez and offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. 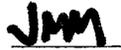
