Background

deed sale proceeds in the amount of \$100,665.28, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court is authorized and directed to disburse this \$100,665.28 to SEEDDHA NHEM, REASEY PRAING AND RAKSMEY PRAING, at 31513 S.W. 208th Court, Homestead, Florida 33030.
