

RESOLUTION NAMING THE CORAL WAY BUS AND
MAINTENANCE GARAGE IN HONOR OF URBANO "AL"
CALDERIN

WHEREAS, in 1961, Urbano "Al" Calderin fled Cuban Communist tyranny for freedom and opportunity in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Urbano "Al" Calderin joined the U.S. Army in 1962 in anticipation of a potential invasion of Cuba to liberate the island nation; and

WHEREAS, for ten years, Urbano "Al" Calderin, in order to support his family, worked a series of jobs during the day while attending school at night to learn English; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 1979, Urbano "Al" Calderin began his career with Miami-Dade Transit as a bus operator trainee; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 1979, Urbano "Al" Calderin completed his training and became a full time bus operator; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 1983, Urbano "Al" Calderin was promoted to the position of Transit Instructor, where he provided training to bus operators; and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1992, Urbano "Al" Calderin was promoted to Division Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2000, Urbano "Al" Calderin was promoted to Chief of Bus Operations; and

WHEREAS, Urbano "Al" Calderin officially retires from County service on May 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Urbano “Al” Calderin’s over 28 years of distinguished public service serves as a testament to the values of hard work, professionalism, and freedom; and

WHEREAS, Urbano “Al” Calderin has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board finds that Urbano “Al” Calderin has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community.

Section 2. By three-fifths of the Board Members present, this Board approves the renaming of the Miami-Dade Transit Coral Way Bus and Maintenance Garage at 2775 S.W. 74th Avenue as the Urbano “Al” Calderin Bus and Maintenance Garage.

The foregoing was sponsored by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and offered by Commissioner _____ who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
