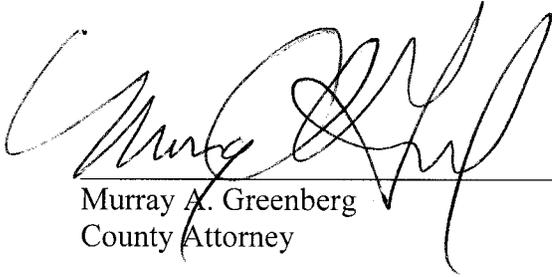

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 96TH STREET
FROM SW 152ND AVENUE TO SW 157TH AVENUE
AS VIPER WAY

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 96th Street from SW 152nd Avenue to SW 157th Avenue as Viper Way; and

WHEREAS, at Felix Varela Senior High School, in order to achieve vision and mission, the administration, faculty, staff, students, and parents are committed to the following beliefs: everyone can learn, it's the community's shared responsibility to create an environment that fosters learning in lifelong learning, equity in education, learning about diversity creates respect for others, teaching must be relevant and meaningful for learning to occur, high expectations are held for students, teaching and learning are an interactive process, teachers must be positive, caring and empathetic; and

WHEREAS, at Felix Varela Senior High School, all students can learn and achieve by challenging them with a student-centered, relevant, and rigorous curriculum, students will perform at high levels and become lifelong learners who will succeed in an ever-changing, multicultural world. By fostering respect for diverse thought and innovation within safe, nurturing, and equitable environment, the students become productive and responsible citizens; and

WHEREAS, since the school mascot is the Viper, the administration, faculty, staff and students would like to honor the school by this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, Felix Varela Senior High School is located at 15255 SW 96th Avenue, Miami, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 96th Street from SW 152nd Avenue to SW 157th Avenue as Viper Way.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
