



SOUTH CAROLINA FIREFIGHTERS WHO PERISHED IN  
THE LINE OF DUTY**

**WHEREAS**, the firefighting profession is one requiring great dedication and commitment in protecting life and property; and

**WHEREAS**, nine veteran Firefighters lost their lives in the line of duty battling a furniture warehouse blaze in Charleston, South Carolina on June 18, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, representatives of the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department attended the public memorial service in Charleston on June 22, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, all citizens of Miami-Dade County and around the nation mourn the passing of these public servants as a result of this tragedy; and

**WHEREAS**, the men and women in the fire service encounter hazards on a daily basis in a dangerous profession; and

**WHEREAS**, these firefighters made the ultimate sacrifice in protecting their community; and

**WHEREAS**, the fire service has experienced a great loss, and the unwavering courage of those who perished will be remembered; and

**WHEREAS**, our hearts and prayers go out to the families, friends and colleagues of those Firefighters,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA** that Miami-Dade County

recognizes the value of the men and women serving their community in the fire service and hereby remembers their courageous dedication to public service and express their heartfelt condolences.
