

RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MANAGER TO PREPARE A REPORT REGARDING THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF DESIGNATING TAXICAB STANDS ON LAND OWNED BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, taxicabs provide an important transportation service in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, taxicab stands provide a convenient and visible location for members of the public to obtain taxicab services, and provide taxicabs a designated location from which they can serve the public; and

WHEREAS, the Taxicab Study issued by the Tennessee Transportation and Logistics Foundation on January 14, 2007 found that there was a need for additional taxicab stands in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that increasing the number of taxicab stands will enhance our transportation system; and

WHEREAS, Metrorail users, for example, may benefit from having taxicab stands located at Metrorail stations to provide them with a convenient transportation option to connect them with their final destination; and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County to explore the feasibility and advisability of designating taxicab stands on County-owned land including, but not limited to, Metrorail stations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is

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directed to prepare a report regarding the feasibility and advisability of designating taxicab stands on land owned by Miami-Dade County. The County Manager shall present a copy of this report to the Economic Development and Human Services Committees within sixty (60) days from the adoption of this resolution.
