

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE MIAMI-DADE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT, AND THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 19, 2008 5K WALK/RUN FOR ASTHMA SPONSORED BY CONTINENTAL SOCIETIES OF GREATER MIAMI, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,375.00 TO BE FUNDED IN PART FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND, AND IN PART FROM THE NON-AD VALOREM PORTION OF THE FIRE RESCUE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Continental Societies of Greater Miami, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Police Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the April 19, 2008 5K Walk/Run For Asthma event in an amount not to exceed \$5,375.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 5K Walk/Run For Asthma event is to educate the community while raising funds to support school based programs as well as the University of Miami's Asthma Clinical Research Center; and

WHEREAS, Continental Societies of Greater Miami, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the 5K Walk/Run For Asthma is a special event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$4,570.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund and \$805.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the non-ad valorem portion of the Fire Rescue In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Police Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the April 19, 2008 5K Walk/Run For Asthma in an amount not to exceed \$5,375.00 to be funded in part from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund and in part from the non-ad valorem portion of the Fire Rescue In-kind Reserve Fund.





Subject: Countywide In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Continental Societies of Greater Miami, Inc. for the 5K Walk/Run for Asthma to be held on April 19, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$670 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services and \$805 from the Miami Dade Fire Rescue Department for the personnel services and \$3,900 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for a total in-kind amount of \$5,375. This event will be funded in part from the countywide in-kind reserve fund and in part from the non-ad valorem portion of the Fire Rescue District Budget.

In FY 2007-08, the Continental Societies of Greater Miami, Inc. has received no County funding for this event.
