Subject: Resolution Authorizing Execution of a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to Provide Additional State Funding for the Flagler MAX Bus Route Service in the Amount of \$450,000

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the execution of a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) in substantially the form attached with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to provide additional State funding in the amount of \$450,000 for a State Transit Corridor project operating as the Flagler MAX bus route. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the receipt and expenditure of funds as specified in this agreement. No County match is required for this program.

SCOPE

While this route is physically located within Commission Districts 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, and 12, the impact of this route benefits the riding public, and is therefore, countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

Under the State Transit Corridor program, FDOT is providing \$450,000 to support continued operation of the Flagler MAX. Since the inception of the Flagler MAX, FDOT has provided approximately \$10.5 million in financial assistance in support of this route through its ongoing annual allocations as supported by the Board.

Current annual operating costs for the Flagler MAX are approximately \$3.2 million. Although no local match is required to receive the subject \$450,000 funding, the balance of the operating costs for this route is provided through MDT's operating revenues, including general fund revenues, as well as proceeds from the Charter County Transit Surtax (Surtax).

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

MDT has entered into numerous funding agreements with FDOT over the course of more than 25 years. The Project Manager for this SJPA is Doug Greist, Manager, MDT Budget and Management Services.

BACKGROUND

Chapter 341 of the Florida Statutes provides State Transit Corridor funding to relieve traffic congestion and improve road capacity within identified transportation corridors. The Flagler MAX was inaugurated in January, 1993, with an initial Transit Corridor Joint Participation Agreement (JPA). FDOT has been providing financial assistance for the operation of the Flagler MAX ever since, with supplemental funding each year.

This route provides limited stop, peak hour, weekday service between the western portion of Miami-Dade County, primarily along West Flagler Street, and Downtown Miami, continuing to Miami Beach via the MacArthur Causeway, and terminating at the Miami Beach Convention Center. For the first nine years of operation (1993-2002), the Flagler MAX operated peak hours only and averaged 1,800 boardings per day. In 2002, midday service was added and ridership has grown to over 4,800 boardings per day.

The most recent Board actions prior to this in support of funding agreements for this route were authorized by Resolution R-1337-05 (December 6, 2005) for \$450,000 and Resolution R-1287-06 (November 28, 2006) also for \$450,000 in State Funds. The State has provided on-going funding in earlier years of a generally similar amount.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SUPPLEMENTAL JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT (SJPA) WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$450,000 FOR OPERATION OF THE FLAGLER MAX BUS ROUTE SERVICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS AS SPECIFIED IN THE SJPA

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida is authorized to enter into agreements to provide State funding for transportation programs and projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That this Board approves the agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Transportation, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, to provide \$450,000 in additional funding to support the operation of the Flagler MAX, a State Transit Corridor project.

Section 2. That this Board further authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute such contracts and agreements as are approved by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend funds in accordance with such aforementioned contracts and agreements; and to file and execute any additional agreements, revisions, or amendments as required to carry out the projects for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Section 3. That the County staff is authorized to furnish such additional information as the FDOT may require in connection with the application for the improvement.
